MEA Scholarship - \$1000 - For student working toward a degree in Entomology or AGPM.

H.C. Mitchell Scholarship - \$1,000 - For student at any level majoring in Entomology or AGPM at MSU

Redd Pest Control Scholarship - \$750 - For graduate student in biological sciences with an emphasis in Entomology at MSU

The Arlie and Ethel Wilson Entomological Endowed Scholarship - Tuition/Fee credit in the amount of \$700 for any undergraduate (AGPM) or graduate student majoring in Entomology at MSU.

Pat and Linda Harris Scholarship - \$1,000 - For graduate student working toward a degree in Entomology or AGPM (\$750). Note: First choice will be given to U.S. citizens.

MEA Scholarship is available to students emphasizing in entomology and attending any higher educational institution in Mississippi, shall be awarded based on academic achievements, grade point average, character, and integrity to a student working toward a degree in entomology or agricultural pest management. A minimum of six (6) hours in entomology and nominations from three (3) faculty members of the supporting institution are required. Recipient will receive a check at the time of the award.

Redd Pest Control Scholarship will be awarded based on scholastic (GPA) and academic achievements to a student working toward an advanced degree in entomology. Three (3) supporting letters of recommendation are required. Recipient will receive a check at the time of the award.

Arlie and Ethel Wilson Entomological Endowed Scholarship must 1) Be full-time undergraduate (AGPM) or graduate student majoring in Entomology at MSU, 2) Have demonstrated a high degree of academic achievement, preferably with a B average or better (3.0 GPA), and 3) be of good moral character and have demonstrated leadership ability and financial need. Letters of recommendation should identify leadership ability and financial need. Funds will be distributed by crediting tuition and fee expenses the semester following the award.

H. C. Mitchell Scholarship shall be awarded to a student majoring in entomology or agricultural pest management at Mississippi State University. The scholarship will be awarded based on scholastic (GPA) and academic achievements, and work experience (in entomology). Financial need will be addressed when appropriate.

Pat and Linda Harris Scholarship will be awarded to a student who 1) is a graduate level student at MSU enrolled in the curriculums within the Department of Entomology and Plant Pathology in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, 2) be of good moral character and have demonstrated a financial need, 3) have demonstrated a high degree of academic achievement with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Preference will be given to applicants not conducting research in cotton. Funds will be distributed by crediting tuition and fee expenses.
